

PLANNING YOUR CATERED MENU

Choosing your Chef Craig's Catering plated or buffet menu style, entrées, and organizing guests for dinner service.



SINGLE ENTRÉE PLATED MENU

Choose up to two entrée options and let your guests choose in advance on an RSVP card.

This menu:

- DOES require guests to choose an entrée in advance.
- DOES require a seating arrangement.
- DOES require place cards.
- DOES require a list of meal choices by table to be turned into catering.
- If you choose only one entrée from this menu for all guests, place cards and meal choice diagram are not required.
- A place card sample and meal choice diagram are due 21 days before your event date.

PLATED DUOS MENU

Choose up to two entrées and all guests will receive BOTH entrées on the same plate.

This menu:

- Does NOT require guests to choose an entrée in advance on an RSVP card.
- Does NOT require a seating arrangement, place cards, or a meal choice diagram.
- EXCEPTION: If you offered a vegetarian meal, gluten free meal, and/or kids meal to select guests then all guests will need a seating arrangement and place cards to indicate meal choice.

BUFFET MENUS

Choose up to two entrées and all guests will receive BOTH entrées from the buffet.

This menu:

- Does NOT require guests to choose an entrée in advance on an RSVP card.
- Does NOT require a seating arrangement, place cards, or a meal choice diagram.
- Does NOT offer a kids menu but instead offers discounts on the buffet meal for children.

PLACE CARDS & MEAL CHOICE DIAGRAM

PLACE CARDS

- Place cards include guest name, table number, and meal choice.
- Place cards must include an indicator of the guest's meal choice in an obvious way.
For example: You chose a chicken entrée and a pork entrée. Your place card indicator could be a silhouette image of a chicken or a pig or a large letter C or P. It should not be arbitrary such as orange = chicken and pink = pig or a circle to indicate chicken and a square to indicate pig.

MEAL CHOICE DIAGRAM

- The diagram should include table number, and number of each entrée at that table number.
For example:
Table 1: 4 chicken, 6 pork
Table 2: 7 chicken, 3 pork etc.

REMINDER

Your final guest count, number of each entrée, place card samples, and meal choice diagram are due to Crow River Winery 21 days before your wedding date.
